commonly chic spaces have garnered her much recognition, including multiple *Detroit Home* Design Awards, along with honors from the American Society of Interior Designers.

DESIGNER'S GOAL: The vision for the space, shown above, began with the Kuba bedding collection from Wildcat Territory. "I loved the colors and the different pops of interest (they add)," Wickman says. "The rest of the fabrics and furnishings worked off of that inspiration." The designer wanted to offer the Novi homeowners a relaxing and timeless space where they could feel calm and insightful in equal measure. The linens complement the room's color scheme and add texture and pattern to the design, making the space interesting as well as comfortable. Blue and brown tones were selected for their calm palette, while the warm hue of the accent wall grounds the space.

- A definite no-no is matching everything. Incorporate different tables and finishes to help make each space unique.

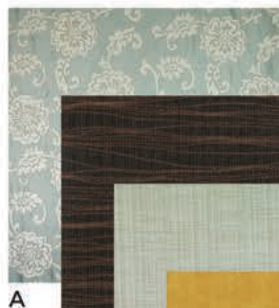

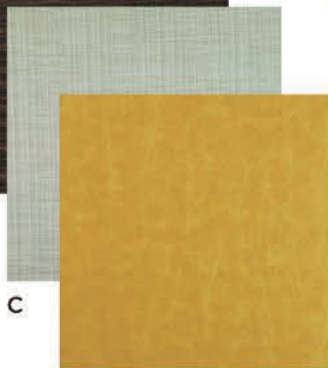

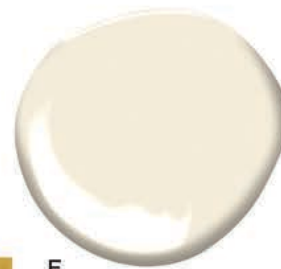
