CALMING NEUTRALS

The designers went with an open iron bed frame, *right*, because it doesn't block sunlight the way a solid one would. Ruching and a sheepskin pillow make the all-white bedding interesting but don't compete with the wallpaper.



WELL-DRESSED

The designers turned an unneeded tiny third bedroom, *far left*, into a closet. Built-in cabinets, a graphic rug, geometric wallpaper on the ceiling, and a mirrored console match style with function.

POWDER PUNCH

Because people don't spend much time in a powder room, *left*, Key says it's a good place to try a bold wallpaper like this graphic red-and-gold pattern. ■
