EAST COAST

Marais Home, an interior design firm and home furnishings store based in Brooklyn's Williamsburg neighborhood, opens tomorrow. **Rinat Lavi**, founder of her own eponymous firm, curated the decor, furniture, lighting and art for the shop, which provides in-house design consultations. The store will be open daily this summer from 12 to 7 p.m. (145 Wythe Avenue, Brooklyn)

Garden State Tile has opened its 15th location, in Columbia, South Carolina. The 3,000-square-foot showroom will cater to the trade with a design room, a conference area, work tables, and a color wall with 130 sample chips. (425 Huger Street, Columbia, South Carolina)
