ALL IN Good Time

Los Angeles-based to-the-trade luxury home goods purveyor **Made Goods** (madegoods.com) has been a designer go-to since the company's founding a decade ago. And though the brand counts showrooms in Atlanta, Dallas, Chicago and New York, opening its fifth in L.A. has been a painstakingly deliberate process. "With L.A. being our home base, we wanted to do it right and find the best location to highlight our products," says president and co-founder Chris DeWitt. "We searched for the perfect space for over two years. And when we first walked into our new space [9011 W. Beverly Blvd., formerly Foundry Lighting] we immediately saw the potential and knew we found our home." Fashioned with dramatic barrel ceilings and expansive front windows, the new 4,500-square-foot showroom is dotted with Made Goods' handmade statement pieces, from marble nesting tables to modern mirrors inspired by leaf coral. The space, which also houses the company's sister lines, Pigeon & Poodle—with handcrafted bath canisters and baskets—and Thucassi, which includes handpoured paraffin wax candles and diffuser sets, is intentionally located near the corporate warehouse. "A designer can not only shop and spec the pieces we have in our showroom, but they also have our deep assortment available to them at a moment's notice," adds DeWitt. What's more, unlike every other Made Goods showroom that caters exclusively to the design community, this location warmly rolls out its welcome mat to the public—a home field advantage, you could say. —JN
